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Videos, Videos, Videos Link - Top Topic in Moodle

- An overview of my video distribution methods
- Links to all videos, by category
 - Link to video (click on video's red-underlined title)
 - Short description
 - Link to download the video
 - Link to download the caption, or SRT file
- Four methods for playing course videos
 - From the links at the top of the "Videos, Videos, and More Videos" web page
 - View on topic's Resources web page
 - View from Moodle's right-side column
 - Download and view on your device

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#1 – Click Link at Top of “Videos, Videos, Videos” Web Page

- Links to all videos by category
- Advantages:
 - Every released video sorted by release date
- Disadvantages
 - Not in context

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#2 – View Videos from Resources Web Page

- Each topic’s resources web page
 - The video opens in your browser
 - Download video and captions buttons
- Advantages:
 - In context
 - Easy
 - “Streams” in your browser
 - Mobile (tablet and smartphone) compatible
- Disadvantages
 - Requires a good Internet connection

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#3 – View Videos from Moodle’s Video Blocks

- Moodle’s Lower right-side (or bottom)
- Same as clicking on the video link in the Resources web page
- Advantages:
 - Collected by group
- Disadvantages
 - Not in context

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#4 – Download Video and Transcript to Your Device

- Click on the “Download” button
- Advantages:
 - Downloaded to computer, tablet, or smartphone
 - Once downloaded, Internet not needed
 - Play video with your favorite video player (might have more features)
 - Videos “on the go” – mobile education!
- Disadvantages
 - Not in context
 - Slightly technical and varied

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
